

MT – Midterm Test

What is MT?

MT is the midterm test for this course.

When?

Feb 15 (Wednesday). During class time. Start 3:30 pm.

Where is it?

The MT is in two different rooms.

- 1. SLH F , (the regular classroom) and**
- 2. CB 121**

Can I take the test in any of the two rooms; or, which room should I go to take the test?

- Students whose LastName starts with one of the letters **A to L** (L included), should go to SLH F (the regular classroom).
- Students whose LastName starts with one the letters **M to Z**, should go to CB 121.

How do I take the test?

MT is a 'traditional' test -- i.e. in class, on paper.

What is on the test?

The material that has been covered since the beginning of the term until (including) the lecture before the test.

Would both rooms have the same test?

Yes.

How long is the test? (i.e. what is the test's duration)

The time allowed to do the test may be *less* than the scheduled lecture time. As in any test, the allotted time will be announced at the beginning of the test.

When does the test start?

At the beginning of the regular lecture start time.

Is the test 'open-book'?

MT is closed-book¬es. In case that some questions are deemed to require 'open notes', then those notes etc will be provided as part of the test.

Can I use any computing or calculating device during the test?

No. (this includes calculators, smartphones, tablets, netbooks, ultrabooks, notebooks, etc.)

What if I miss the test?

Then the weight of the test would be automatically transferred to the final exam.

What if I don't miss the test, yet I think that I could have done better?

You will have the opportunity to 'nullify' the test in March (through the 'Annulment Form') and your MT weight would be transferred to the final exam.
