

Performance/Results: In the 2010-11 fiscal year, actual undergraduate FTE enrolments were above plans for both eligible and ineligible enrolments













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
The graphs below show the number of eligible and ineligible Undergraduate and Graduate Full-Time Equivalents at York University by responsible faculty





















Eligible and Ineligible Undergraduate and Graduate FTEs - Faculty of Health















The graphs below represent the total number of new eligible undergraduates for the Fall term by home faculty
























# Percentage of New Year 1 Registrants from Secondary School With an Entry Average of 75% or Better




The graphs below represent the number of students with an average of 75% or higher who registered at York University in the Fall term


**Performance/Results:** The proportion of students who entered the University with an average over 75% or better increased substantially in 2010-11 and is almost at the 2006-07 high water mark



























Graduate Admissions: Eligible New Graduate Students (Fall Term) Faculty of Environmental Studies














Performance/Results: While the percentage of Masters students who received external funding is at a 5 year high, the percentage of doctoral students receiving external funding is at a 5 year low.









