



DAY 7 | OCT 9 | JAIPUR (B)

Amber Fort

The day ends with a chef's demo, a talk on Assam's geography and industries, and a relaxed dinner aboard.

DAY 14 | OCT 16 | BISHWANATH GHAT - SILGHAT (B, L, D)

Wake up to the soothing sounds of the river and enjoy breakfast onboard. Today, visit Bishwanath Ghat, a quaint village renowned for its skilled weavers and vibrant textiles. Witness the art of weaving firsthand and interact with the local artisans. Later, sail to Silghat and visit a tea estate or a jute mill to understand the intricate processes involved in these industries. Conclude your day with a cultural performance onboard followed by dinner.

DAY 15 | OCT 17 | KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK (B, L, D)

Awaken to the allure of Assam tea and set off from Silghat to the Agoratoli Eastern Range of Kaziranga for an exhilarating Jeep Safari, encountering vibrant wildlife like Rhinos, Asiatic water buffaloes, and deer. After the safari, journey to the Central Range for a lavish lunch at a resort. Here, you'll have the opportunity to see majestic elephants amidst the verdant landscape. Continue your adventure to the Bagori Western Range for another thrilling Jeep Safari, where you'll spot the iconic one-horned rhinoceros and other exotic species. Conclude your day's exploration and return to Silghat to board the MV Mahabaahu Cruise.

Proceed to Guwahati Airport with packed lunch, then fly to Delhi. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before transferring to the airport for your international flight home.







DAY 1 | OCT 19 | GUWAHATI – PARO – THIMPHU (B, D)



DAY 3 | OCT 21 | THIMPHU – PARO (*B*, *L*, *D*) Begin your day with a visit to the National Library, which houses an extensive collection of Buddhist literature. Later, embark on a scenic journey to Paro, a valley steeped in cultural richness, myths, and awe-inspiring beauty. Upon arrival, dive into history at Ta Dzong, now transformed into the National Museum, and marvel at the architectural grandeur of Rinpung Dzong, a historic fortress that stands as a testament to Bhutan's rich heritage.



DAY 4 | OCT 22 | PARO (B, L, D)

Rise early for an exhilarating hike to the iconic Taktsang Monastery, often referred to as the "Tiger's Nest." This spiritual site, clinging to a cliffside, offers breathtaking views and a profound sense of serenity. Post-hike, visit Kyichu Lakhang, one of Bhutan's oldest and most sacred temples, steeped in legends and history. The remainder of the day is yours to explore Paro at your own pace, indulge in local crafts, or simply relax amidst the serene landscapes.
