

AP/SOSC 2110:6 A Critical Study of Health and Society

JOURNAL EXERCISE due 22 March 2012

Using your journal writings as primary source material, analyze your own intellectual journey through AP/SOSC 2110 in the following way:

Consider the evolution of your ideas about health and society as they are reflected in your journals, answering two or more of the following questions. What insights did you gain over the academic year? What connections did you make between course material and the world in which you live? In what ways have you become more critical or informed regarding issues relating to health? What have you learnt from 2110, and how might you apply knowledge from the course to your own life?

Your answer should be 750-1,000 words (3-4 pages long), typed and double-spaced in 12 pt font. Papers of more than 1,500 words are not acceptable.

Please note that this assignment is based on your journals and you are expected to quote from and refer to your journals. Cite your journals by identifying them by number or date AND hand in all copies of your journals. YOU ARE NOT MEANT TO REFERENCE OR MAKE USE OF ANY ADDITIONAL MATERIALS.

Be sure to keep an extra copy of the paper which you hand in.
