



Math Proficiency Test (MPT) Fact Sheet for Ontario Teacher Candidates

**ON OR AFTER
FEBRUARY 1, 2025**

Applying for a General Certificate of Qualification and Registration (CQR)?

If you submit a complete application to the College before February 1, 2025, you will not be required to pass the MPT.

If you submit a complete application to the College on or after February 1, 2025, you will be required to pass the MPT.

Applying for a Transitional Certificate (TCQR) or Multi-Session Transitional Certificate (MTCQR)?

If you are granted a TCQR or MTCQR and convert to a General CQR before February 1, 2025, you will not be required to pass the MPT.

If you are granted a TCQR or MTCQR and do not convert to a General CQR before February 1, 2025, you will be required to pass the MPT before you can convert.

Do you hold a Transitional Certificate or Multi-Session Transitional Certificate?

If you convert your TCQR or MTCQR to a General CQR before February 1, 2025, you will not be required to pass the MPT.

If you do not convert your TCQR or MTCQR to a General CQR before February 1, 2025, you will be required to pass the MPT before you can convert.

Registration will open at mathproficiencytest.ca by September 9, 2024. Test sittings are scheduled to begin in October.

If you are enrolled in, or have completed, a Teacher of a Native Language program, you are exempt from the MPT requirement.
