General Admission Requirements 😢*



FRENCH BACCALAUREATE

Baccalauréat général with a minimum overall score of 10 (mention passable) from a French lycée accredited by the Ministry of Education or an accrediting agency in France.

** Transfer Credits: A maximum of 30 credits may be granted for most academic courses with a grade of 12 or better.

GCEs

Minimum of two Advanced Level (A-level) passes and three GCSE or IGCSE Ordinary Level (O-level) passes.

A minimum average of "C" is required on Advanced Level, Advanced Subsidiary Level and Ordinary Level passes.

** Transfer Credits: A maximum of 18 credits may be granted for A Level courses completed with a grade of C or better.

INTERNATIONAL **BACCALAUREATE (IB) DIPLOMA**

IB diploma with passes in six subjects: three passes at the Standard Level and three passes at the Higher Level; or two passes at the Standard Level and four passes at the Higher Level.

Minimum diploma point scores of 30 or higher recommended (Scores of 28 will be considered).

** Transfer Credits: A maximum of 30 credits may be granted for most academic courses with a grade of 12 or better.

CAPE

Diploma with a total of at least six units, including prerequisites, and grades of 1, 2 or 3 in each unit.

A minimum overall average of 3 out of 7 is required.

** Transfer Credits: A maximum of 18 credits may be granted for most 2-unit academic courses with grades of 1, 2 or 3.

3-Year Degree Option

Finish your studies earlier than you thought with our 3-year degree pathways in most Bachelor programs.

Language Requirements

If you studied in a French-language high school, you will be exempt from providing a language proficiency test. If you studied in an English-language high school, you may also be exempt.

Pathway to Permanent Residency

Through the Francophone Minority Communities Student Pilot with the Government of Canada, studying at Glendon can be your

first step towards permanent residency. See website for a list of eligible countries.
