Admission Requirements

- › An Honors BA or equivalent with at least B (second class) standing from a recognized university, preferably with an art history major and studio experience. An undergraduate major presupposes at least five full-year courses (or equivalent) in art history. Language Requirements: A minimum of two languages: English and one other, which is usually French. Each student must give satisfactory evidence of a reading knowledge of art historical literature in another language other than English as appropriate to the research program.
