- › Graduates with an honors degree or equivalent in digital media or related Bachelor's program from a recognized university, such as an art program that focuses on technology, with at least a B average in the final two years of study, may be considered for admission as candidates for the MA degree. Applicants must show that they have experience in both programming and the arts, and in particular a cross-disciplinary approach.
