## Master of Environmental Studies (MES)



The Master in Environmental Studies (MES) program prepares students to be agents of environmental and urban change through research, teaching, activism, artistic and professional practice. In this program, centred on an individual Plan of Study, you will learn how to redefine the boundaries of environmental research to create positive social and environmental change. The MES program will challenge you to look at natural, socio-cultural and built environments differently.

- Personal plan of study & Research Paper OR Project or Portfolio OR Thesis, (6 terms), Part-time available

- › An applicant must normally have an honors (four year) undergraduate degree from an accredited university with an academic standing of at least a “B+” or such factors as significant work or volunteer experience, or participation in other relevant activities, that are determined to be equivalent by the Faculty of Environmental & Urban Change.
