**Master of Public and International Affairs (MPIA)** 



Housed in Canada's first bilingual School of Public and International Affairs, the two-year Master's offers high level bilingual preparation for leadership roles in public life. The program focuses on analyzing the key challenges in Canadian public life, placing Canadian public institutions in a global setting and applying the core knowledge and tools of public management and policy. Courses draw from many disciplines and areas, including Canadian studies, economics, history, international studies, law, philosophy, political science, sociology and women's studies

# **Admission Requirements**

- Candidates must have completed an honors undergraduate degree program or equivalent (typically a four-year program with full-time enrolment) from an accredited post-secondary institution with a minimum grade point average of B+ in the final two years of study is required. Experience in public sector employment is desirable but not required.
- Applicants are required to be proficient in at least one of Canada's official languages with at least a working knowledge of the other language.
