**Requirement Checklist and Notes (To ensure graduation, each box must be checked 'completed')**

- Residency Requirement: a minimum of 30 course credits and at least half (50 per cent) of the course credits required in each undergraduate degree program major/minor must be taken at York University.
- Upper-level Requirement: at least 18 credits at the 3000 or 4000-level, including 18 credits at 4000-level.
- Cumulative grade point average of at least 5.0.
- International exchange: at least one full term abroad as a full-time student at one of York University's exchange partners
