Introduction

This selected bibliography on aspects of Canada-Japan relations is comprehensive, but not exhaustive. It comprises mainly books and articles written in English on political and trade relations between the two countries and on Japanese Canadians. Every attempt has been made to include the most recent materials. Some items with overlapping subject matter appear twice.

Your topic will probably require that you search beyond what is listed here. A number of Canadian manuscript and oral history collections may contain relevant materials. Or, for some topics, newspaper, magazine and even television archives can also be the source of valuable information. Computerized data bases now include information relevant to research projects on Canada-Japan relations. There is also a considerable body of material in Japanese, although not much of it is available in Canada. This bibliography is thus a starting point. It contains what we consider the core of any reading list on the topic.

To save you from foraging too long, here are some suggestions on where to begin your search in the three subject categories of this bibliography. On the topic of political and economic relations, two studies provide a general overview: Klaus H. Pringsheim, *NEIGHBORS ACROSS THE PACIFIC* and Frank Langdon, *THE POLITICS OF CANADIAN-JAPANESE ECONOMIC RELATIONS, 1952-1983*. The Canada-Japan Trade Council publishes a number of studies each year on current business trends involving the two countries.

If your interest is Japanese-Canadians, the best place to start is with Ken Adachi, *THE ENEMY THAT NEVER WAS: A HISTORY OF THE JAPANESE CANADIANS* and Ann Gomer Sunahara, *THE POLITICS OF RACISM: THE UPROOTING OF JAPANESE CANADIANS DURING THE SECOND WORLD WAR*. Each of these studies has an extensive bibliography that can be used along with this guide.

We owe special gratitude to Kenneth K. Curtis and Paul Summerville whose pioneering bibliography of Canada-Japan relations appears in **Tsukuba Daigaku Chiiki Kenkyu (Area Studies, Tsukuba)** 4 (1986) 275-291. We discovered their bibliography in the course of compiling our own. Categories, scope and criteria for inclusion were sufficiently different, however, to justify compilation of a different and more up-to-date bibliography. Moreover, the journal in which their list appears is not easily available in Canada. The other major sources are listed on page 36.

Special thanks also go to the Nakasone Programme of the Japan Foundation which funded the Documentation Centre research project of which this study was a part.
