WHAT IS PHOTOVOICE?

- Photovoice uses
 photography to empower
 participants as co researchers
- Photovoice looks at the significance of camera use and at topics such as power and ethics in photography
- Consent is thoroughly reviewed in the first session and participants have the choice of opting out of the study

BENEFITS OF THE STUDY

- Identify the challenges Filipina care workers face at work
- You will play an important role in ensuring that the experiences of Filipina care workers on the frontlines of the pandemic are recognized

 The photo exhibit and policy brief that will be produced from the project will be shared with community advocates and organizations to amplify their work in advocating for

the needs of care workers during COVID-19

 The academic community will benefit from this study by showing how migrant care workers fare during COVID-19, thereby contributing to the literature on immigration, care work, gender, and social justice
