- @Ross Arnold This depends in our experience on how many annual planned outputs you have. OA fees are eligible, but in practice can be targeted by committees for budget reductions. It is important to justify why a journal is targeted, and why an OA fee is truly essential. Many journals already meet the current Tri-Agency OA publication standard. you can check this in at the Sherpa-Romeo site: <https://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/>
