#### **Deputy Minister Seminar on Disruptive Technology**

York University, in collaboration with the Canada School of Public Service (CSPS), hosted a seminar titled, Disruptive AI, for federal public servants in Ottawa. It was delivered by Professor James Elder, York Research Chair in Human and Computer Vision and Co-Director of the Centre of AI & Society. Professor Elder discussed how AI is transforming society, including education, the creative industries, healthcare and transportation, and as with any disruptive technology, how there are many opportunities as well as risks to identify in this area. His remarks emphasized how leaders can strengthen linkages between academic, industry and public sectors, particularly focusing on the integration of AI into existing fabrics of technology and public policy in these key domains.


