Developing a <u>co</u>mprehensive <u>mobility discharge assessment framework</u> (COMDAF) for older adults transitioning from hospital to home through knowledge synthesis and international e-Delphi method

Dr. Kalu's research is comprehensive, intersecting the multifactorial (cognitive, environmental, financial, physical, psychological, personal and social determinants), multifaceted (self-reported and objective measures - real-life mobility measure and lab-based), and multidisciplinary aspects of mobility assessment, prevention, and intervention among older adults across various care settings, from hospital-to-home transition to community and long-term care facilities.

He continued to maintain interest in exploring strategies (e.g., education and practice frameworks) to enhance the transdisciplinary approach to older adult social/functional health grounded in physiotherapy practice philosophies. He is currently the Scientific Director of the Emerging Researchers & Professionals in Ageing - African Network.
