
## Dr. Glen Jones - speaker at YURA 2024 AGM

Dr. Glen A. Jones is Professor of Higher Education, and former dean of the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education of the University of Toronto. He holds the Ontario Research Chair in Postsecondary Education Policy and Measurement, and he is the Director of the Centre for the Study of Canadian and International Higher Education.



Dr. Jones is the author of more than 150 papers in the field of higher education. His research and teaching interests focus on higher education policy, governance and academic work. His recent books include the second edition of *Governance* of Higher Education: Global Perspectives, Theories and Practices (with Ian Austin, Routledge, 2024), The Role of Governing Boards in Canadian Higher Education: Sociological Perspectives on the Form and Functioning of Boards (with Dominik Antonowicz, Routledge, 2023), Internationalization and the Academic Profession: Comparative Perspectives (with Alper Calikoglu and Yangson Kim, Springer, 2023), University Governance in Canada: Navigating Complexity

(with Julia Eastman, Claude Trottier and Olivier Bégin-Caouette, McGill-Queen's, 2022), Universities and the Knowledge Society: The Nexus of National Systems of Innovation and Higher Education (with Timo Aarrevaara, Martin Finkelstein, and Jisun Jung, Springer, 2021), International Education as Public Policy in Canada (with Merli Tamtik and Roopa Desai Trilokekar, McGill-Queens, 2020), and Professorial Pathways: Academic Careers in a Global Perspective (with Martin Finkelstein, Johns Hopkins University Press, 2019).

Dr. Jones is a past president of the Canadian Society for the Study of Higher Education and a former editor of the Canadian Journal of Higher Education. He received the Distinguished Research Award from the Canadian Society for the Study of Higher Education in 2001 and their Distinguished Member Award in 2011. He received an honorary degree from the University of Manitoba in 2018. He has won awards for his research from the Canadian Bureau on International Education and the Council on International Higher Education (ASHE) in the United States. He has held Visiting Professor appointments at the University of Hong Kong (2023), the University of the West Indies (Open Campus Barbados, 2015), Beijing Normal University (2014-2019), Fudan University (2007-2008) and he was an Erasmus Mundus Visiting Scholar at the University of Oslo (2008).

He has held a range of administrative appointments including department chair and Dean (2015-2021) at OISE, University of Toronto and has received several awards for his contributions to academic leadership. He is currently a member of the (Alberta government) Minister's Advisory Committee on Higher Education and Skills.
